CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Club of St. Andrews, Scotland and subject to such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place.
2. The Tournament Match Committee makes all arrangements, and has full power to alter the conditions, should they deem it desirable, and shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
3. Any dispute or protest will be decided by the Tournament Match Committee whose decision is final.
4. Full payment must accompany entry form.
5. No entry fee will be refunded after the closing date.
6. The Tournament Match Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries.
7. Eligible substitutes are accepted.
8. Motorised transportation is prohibited. If a player has a permanent disability or is recovering from serious injury or illness and is unable to play without the use of a motorised vehicle or bike, the player must obtain a doctor's certificate and approval of the Tournament Match Committee at the time of entry.
9. All competitors will be made Honorary Members for the day.
10. Golf activities can be inherently dangerous. All competitors understand that they are exposed to certain risks during golf activities and that accidents can and often do happen. Acceptance of entry releases Gisborne Golf Club from all claims that entrants may have or may have had but for this release arising from or in connection with participation and indemnifies each competitor and will keep indemnified Gisborne Golf Club in respect of any claim by any person arising as a result of or in connection with participation in any golf activities.
11. Gisborne Golf Club has a comprehensive public liability cover; however this does not extend to personal accident insurance for each competitor.
12. Competitors acknowledge that any images or photos taken during this event may be used by Gisborne Golf Club for publicity and promotional purposes.
13. Ties will be decided by countback according to Golf Australia recommendations.
14. Competitors shall use their official Social Club handicaps, however, the maximum handicap allowed for this Championship shall be 27.
